About the Study:

Pakistan Centre for Philanthropy pioneer research study to assess the magnitude and patterns of individual giving at National Level. Nearly 98% of Pakistani's either give through cash, in kind, or time volunteered.

Approximately 10,000 households sampled in four provinces of Pakistan. Individuals have reported that their giving stems from religious reasons but compassion also matters.

Strong preference for giving directly to individuals, especially the beggars and disabled.
Motivation for giving to institutions that address local needs
